

Postgraduate study (under special degree programs) in the form of an application for foreign citizens in the State Institution "Scientific and Practical Center of the State Forensic Examination Committee of the Republic of Belarus " (hereinafter - Center)

In accord with the Regulation on training of scientists of higher qualification in the Republic of Belarus, approved by the Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus dated 01.12.2011 No. 561 (as amended by the Decrees dated 30.12.2011 No. 621, dated 16.12.2013 No. 560), foreign citizens are enrolled in postgraduate studies on a paid basis without passing an entrance exam to study (under special degree program) in the form of an application (no more than 5 years). Herewith, the applicant's propensity for scientific research work, as well as the level of proficiency in the language of instruction, sufficient to master the educational program of postgraduate studies, is established by the results of an interview.

Foreign citizens entering postgraduate studies should have a higher education at the level of a Master of Science (Arts). Those who have not passed entrance exams for postgraduate studies in the Republic of Belarus are enrolled for training (under special degree program) in the form of an application: for a period not exceeding five years - for preparing and passing postgraduate exams and tests, as well as for performing a thesis research.

List of documents for foreign citizens admission to postgraduate studies:

1. An application addressed to the Center CEO;
2. Protocol of the results of an interview;
3. Copies of higher education diplomas (bachelor's, master's), translated into Russian and certified by a notary (if the diplomas were issued in a foreign country);
4. A copy of a supplement to the diploma, certified by a notary, with a translation into Russian (if the diploma was issued in a foreign country);
5. Certificate of an education document (issued to a person in a foreign state) recognition, its equivalence (compliance) with a document on education of the Republic of Belarus.

Stateless persons of the Republic of Belarus and foreign citizens who are holders of foreign diplomas of higher education and academic degrees, before submitting documents for admission to postgraduate studies, should confirm the equivalence (compliance) of their foreign documents to Belarusian diplomas of higher education and academic degrees in the manner prescribed by the Legislative Acts of the Republic of Belarus.

To obtain a certificate of an education document (issued to a person in a foreign state) recognition and to establish its equivalence (conformity) with a document on education of the Republic of Belarus, recognition and establishment of compliance with the periods of study and

6. A personal record sheet.

7. A resume.

8. A list and copies of the published scientific works and, in case of their absence, a scientific abstract on the profile of the specialty (for persons entering postgraduate study to obtain the scientific qualification "Researcher").

9. Documents confirming participation in the implementation of research and innovation projects, copies of materials and / or abstracts of reports at scientific, research and practical conferences, congresses, symposia and other similar events (if any).

10. An application of a personnel contracting authority (if any).

11. A conclusion of the laboratory's scientific seminar on the relevance of the topic, the quality and volume of the independently carried out research on the topic of the thesis prepared by.

12. A copy of an employment record or other documents confirming the work experience (for persons entering postgraduate study to obtain the scientific qualification "Researcher").

For persons, entering postgraduate studies under special degree programs, it is compulsory to have practical experience of at least two years in positions requiring higher education.

13. Three photographs 4 x 6 cm.

14. A passport copy or the one of a document replacing it, a document confirming the right to stay in the Republic of Belarus, contract of a compulsory health insurance.

15. Conclusion of a medical consultation commission issued by a territorial health organization of the Republic of Belarus (after undergoing the compulsory medical examination by an assignment of the Center).

16. A medical report on the state of health and a certificate of HIV infection absence issued by an official health authority of the country from which the candidate for postgraduate studies came.

17. An Agreement

An identity document and original documents on education are presented by a person, entering postgraduate study, personally.

Foreign citizens and stateless persons entering postgraduate study to obtain the scientific qualification "Researcher" or for training under special degree programs, in order to pass entrance

exams and tests (differentiated tests) for postgraduate studies, in accordance with international treaties of the Republic of Belarus, treaties on the implementation of international programs, Agreements of the Scientific and Practical Center with the organizations of foreign states (international organizations) or by an assignment of a foreign state organization, provide an additional copy of one of the above mentioned Agreements or an assignment of a foreign state organization.

During the postgraduate study (under special degree program) in the form of an application, one should pass the following entrance exams and a test: 1) in philosophy and methodology of science (entrance exam), 2) in Russian as a foreign language (entrance exam), 3) in the basics of information technology (a differential test), 4) entrance exam in the specialty under which the research thesis is carried out.

The estimated cost of training per year is 2450 Belarusian rubles or \$ 960. The issues of the need, organization and payment of training in the disciplines of the postgraduate entrance exams are discussed individually.

Postgraduates undergo current certification - at least twice a year - for monitoring development of the educational program and implementation of individual work plans by them. A postgraduate is certified on the basis of a report submitted by him (the report is prepared in printed form, its copy is kept by the postgraduate, the signed and executed original of the report is to be submitted on time).

In the final year, not later than ten days before the end of the training period, postgraduates undergo final certification. The final certification is carried out in the form of a report on the implementation of the individual work plan for the entire period of study and is carried out by the State Examination Commission (SEC).
